CHABOT TO KEYNOTE LAW ENFORCEMENT AWARDS GALA

(INLAND EMPIRE, CA) – April 27th 2010 - 63rd Assembly Candidate, LT Commander (s) Paul Chabot, to keynote Riverside Police Officers Association Annual Awards Gala this Saturday.

Chabot has accepted an invitation to keynote the 2nd Annual Riverside Police Officers Association "Safe in His Arms" Awards Gala and Ceremony. The event is scheduled for May 1st, 2010 at the Riverside Convention Center.
