Chabot has extensive background in public safety, crime, drugs, gangs and border issues. He has 15-years of street level law enforcement experience; served six-years for the White House Drug Czars Office; served in the U.S. State Department's Office of Inspector General, and also served with the U.S. Attorney's Office in Los Angeles assessing measures to reduce methamphetamine production and use. Chabot served three Gubernatorial appointments to the parole board; founded the Inland Valley Drug Free Community Coalition and the Coalition for a Drug Free California. He has authored a number of strategies and is currently writing a book on drug cartel violence.

LT Commander Chabot (s), a former active duty special operations intelligence officer, is a leading candidate for the 63rd assembly seat currently held by Assemblyman Bill Emmerson who will step down due to term limits. Chabot resides in Rancho Cucamonga with his wife Brenda, and their three children.
