LT. COMMANDER(S) PAUL CHABOT ANNOUNCES CALIFORNIA  
NARCOTICS OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (CNOA) ENDORSEMENT.

(INLAND EMPIRE, CA) – This past week, the California Narcotics Officers Association (CNOA) voted unanimously to endorse LT. Commander(s) Paul Chabot to succeed current Assemblyman Bill Emmerson in the 63<sup>rd</sup> Assembly District seat. LT.
