The CA Political Reform Act (prop 34) place limits on contributions to candidates for state offices. An individual, political action committee, association, committee, partnership, business or corporation may contribute a maximum of \$3,900 to the primary election and \$3,900 for the general. A husband and wife may each contribute \$3,900 per primary and general elections. A Small Contributor Committee may contribute a maximum of \$7,800 to the committee per election.
