LT. COMMANDER(S) PAUL CHABOT CANDIDATE FOR 63rd AD BRIEFS WHITE HOUSE DRUG CZAR

(SAN DIEGO, CA) – Paul Chabot, founder of the Drug Free California organization and candidate for the 63rd Assembly District met with White House Appointed Drug Czar, Gil Kerlikowske to brief the official on the dangers posed to our communities following the potential early release of thousands of California inmates. Combined with the growing threat faced at the border from violent Mexican Drug Cartels, Dr. Chabot made the point clear that this is a dangerous game being played that goes against good judgment.

Dr. Chabot was also invited as a keynote speaker at an event addressing the National Narcotic Officers Associations Coalition held in San Diego. Later, Paul toured the border to witness firsthand both the progress made and challenges faced by the California Border Patrol.

“I’m proud of the accomplishments made by the California Border Patrol, but clearly we have our work cut out for us here. We have already experienced quite a strain on our resources in the Inland Empire as a result of illegal border crossings and drug trafficking and this problem isn’t going anywhere unless we do something about it” stated Dr. Chabot upon wrapping up his visit.
